### TOYO TOP GLOBAL SCHOLARSHIP A

A world-class education for tomorrow's Top Global Leaders:

Toyo Top Global Scholarship A offers unprecedented access to an elite education free from financial burdens. Students selected for this Scholarship receive waivers for full tuition and all associated fees, plus generous financial support for all four years of their education at Toyo.

#### Allotments

Tuition and all associated fees waived; Monthly Stipend JPY 150,000

#### Spots Available

Department of Global Innovation Studies: 30 students/year

Department of Regional Development: 10 students/year

Department of Information Networking for Innovation and Design: 20 students/year

#### Benefit Period

Four years (with graduation coming at the end of the fourth year)

#### Housing

Toyo will provide the housing for the first year. Students are responsible for paying the rent out of the monthly scholarship stipend.

#### Responsibility

Toyo Top Global Scholars are expected to cooperate with Toyo University in its endeavor to internationalize its education and research, through participating in various programs and activities both during their studies at Toyo and as alumni.

#### Remarks

Scholarships will be disbursed after the recipient starts the program at Toyo University. If required academic standards are not maintained, the scholarship will be reduced or suspended after the second year. Any combination with other Toyo scholarships is not allowed.

## Application Eligibility for Admission & Toyo Top Global Scholarship A

Eligible persons must satisfy all of the following conditions (1 to 4):

1. Be a national of a country other than Japan.
2. Have completed (or is expected to complete) a 12-year education curriculum or the equivalent\* in a country other than Japan by the time of the entrance to the university.
3. The person must satisfy one of the following English proficiency requirements or the equivalent. The test score must be from a test taken on or after September 1, 2016. Scores from TOEFL ITP®, TOEFL® CBT, IELTS™ (General Training Module), and TOEIC®-IP will not be accepted.
  - TOEFL iBT® score of 79 or higher
  - TOEFL® PBT score of 550 or higher
  - IELTS™ score of 6.0 or higher
  - TOEIC® score of 780 or higher
4. The person is seeking to enter Toyo University (desired department and course) as his or her first choice.
